RESOLUTION 2022-79
APPROVING CARRYOVER OF VACATION HOURS FOR PLANNING & ZONING
INSPECTOR/ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT LIAISON

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and related staffing issues the Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison was unable to use 56 hours of vacation time during calendar year 2021, and;

WHEREAS, Village Council intended to authorize carryover of that time for use or payout during calendar year 2022, but due to a pending audit that authorization has not yet occurred, and;

WHEREAS, the 2021 audit has concluded and any prior issues regarding carryover of vacation hours have been resolved, and;

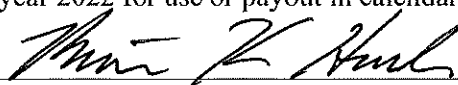
WHEREAS, Village Council, per the Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison's contract, is authorized to fix other such terms and conditions of employment relating to the performance of the employee as it may determine is necessary or desirable, provided such are not inconsistent or in conflict with the Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison's agreement, the Village Charter or other law, and;

WHEREAS, Village Council now intends to authorize the carryover of the hours for use or payout in 2022;

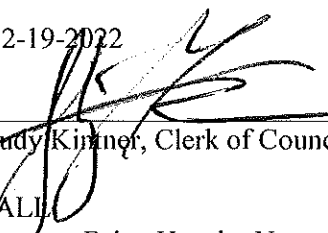
NOW THEREFORE, Council for the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio hereby resolves that:

Section 1. The Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison's contract as of January 1, 2022 did not allow for the carryover of more than 5 days of vacation; however, due to the extenuating circumstances of COVID-19 pandemic, the Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison was unable to use her vacation time in 2021. Therefore, Council shall exercise the powers delineated in Section 11 of the Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison's contract and will fix other such terms and conditions of employment as it may determine is necessary or desirable, provided such are not inconsistent or in conflict with the Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison's agreement, the Village Charter or other law.

Section 2. Council hereby authorizes the Village Manager to authorize in writing the carryover of 56 hours for the Planning & Zoning Inspector/Economic Development Liaison from calendar year 2021 to calendar year 2022 for use or payout in calendar year 2022.
