

**VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS, OHIO
RESOLUTION 2023-36**

**AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH
DIGITAL ALLY FOR IN-CAR DASH CAMERA SYSTEMS FOR THE YELLOW
SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, Yellow Springs Police Department has, since 2010, maintained a best practice of recording footage, known as "dash-cam footage" from police vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, Council agrees that continued use of vehicle dash cameras will provide the opportunity to review Village of Yellow Springs police officers' actions and reactions in the field and can provide valuable data when an incident becomes part of an ongoing investigation; and,

WHEREAS, The YSPD, after carefully vetting reputable providers of complete systems compatible with the need to provide records when requested, and to redact those records per Ohio Revised Code, and with the further desire to streamline digital recordings to a single provider, has selected Digital Ally as the preferred provider for this service; and,

WHEREAS, the lowest and best quote found for a provider for combined hardware and software support is Digital Ally, who require a five year contract. Additionally, because Digital Ally provides hardware/software support for YSPD body cameras, all camera systems will operate in a similar fashion, decreasing the learning curve for officers and records providers,

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Yellow Springs, State of Ohio that:

Section 1: The Village Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a five-year contract with Digital Ally for provision of an in-vehicle camera system and all necessary software, storage and support, in a form substantially similar to the agreement shown in Exhibit A and as finally approved by the Village Solicitor.
