NAMING KYLE CALHOUN AS MUNICIPAL REPRESENTATIVE TO THE GREENE
COUNTY 911 REVIEW COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, House Bill 33 was passed by the Ohio Legislature, modifying the composition of the 911 Review Committees for all counties in Ohio, and

WHEREAS, as part of that modification, there is to be “a member of the legislative authority of a municipal corporation in the county selected by a majority of the legislative authorities of municipal corporations in the county pursuant to resolutions they adopt”, and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Interim Village Manager, it is the decision of Council for the Village of Yellow Springs, Ohio that it would be in the best interest of the Greene County municipalities to appoint Kyle Calhoun, a council member of the Village of Jamestown, as municipal representative to the Greene County 911 Review Committee,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF YELLOW SPRINGS THAT,

Section 1. Kyle Calhoun, a council member of the Jamestown Village Council, is Yellow Springs Village Council’s selection for appointment to the Greene County 911 Review Committee as the representative of the municipal corporations of Greene County, Ohio.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
