CALL TO ORDER

President of Council Gavin DeVore Leonard called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm.

ROLL CALL

Present were Council President DeVore Leonard, Vice President Angie Hsu and Council members Carmen Brown, Senay Semere and Stephanie Pearce. AVM/Project Lead Elyse Giardullo and Village Manager Johnnie Burns were also present.

LEGISLATION

Reading of Resolution 2026-24 Adopting a Cybersecurity Program for the Village of Yellow Springs. Hsu MOVED and Pearce SECONDED a MOTION TO APPROVE.

Burns explained that House Bill 96 has mandated that all Villages adopt a cybersecurity program by July 1, 2026. Once adopted, he said, the Village will have 60-90 days in which to implement the program. He noted that the measure does require that any funds necessary to implement the program be appropriated by Council.

Burns noted further that the policy is not subject to public record requests and may not be made public.

DeVore Leonard CALLED THE VOTE, and the MOTION PASSED 5-0 ON A VOICE VOTE.

At 4:35pm, Brown MOVED and Hsu SECONDED a MOTION TO ADJOURN. The MOTION PASSED 5-0 ON A VOICE VOTE.
